



Health and Safety Policy

General Statement

It is the policy of Greening Electrical to recognise our responsibility to ensure a healthy and safe working environment at all times to prevent injury to personnel.

Responsibilities

- **Adequate facilities for welfare at work**
- **Protective clothing and equipment**

Employee and Subcontractor Responsibilities

It is the duty of every employee or subcontractor whilst at work to:

- **Take care of both their own health and safety and the health and safety of others who may be affected or influenced by their actions**
- **Co-operate with the organisation in fulfilling our legal and moral obligations.**
